The Area Reps are your local contact and will have knowledge of individual members and breeders in your area, so if you are looking to purchase sheep or need to loan a ram, they would be your first point of call. Alternatively, if you are new to the breed and require assistance to understand the breed points of the Society etc, they can arrange to visit you or someone who lives nearby to do so - ensuring you get off to a good start with the breed.

FLOCK RETURN 2019

The Grassroots System does not support Flock Return requests and therefore for this year we will have to stick to the paper version! However, the form is much shorter and only requests your Flock Information.

If there is a change to your contact details, the GDPR restrictions that you wish on your information (i.e. what information is displayed on the website and Flock Book), then this can be advised and changed at any time throughout the year via Grassroots.
