ROYAL WELSH SHOW 2025

Royal Welsh 2025. Another fast and furious occasion in the Llanwenog Calander and this year did not disappoint.

Before I begin my report there are, as always, a few thank you's to make. To the Judge, Mr Eurig Evans, Penrherber flock, a daunting task to Judge the Royal Welsh, but a great honour to be asked. Because he hadn't seen any sheep all year, little did he know how many sheep would enter the ring, and at one point he whispered, "they're still coming in". Once again, the breed put on a fantastic show of quality and shine. With the ringside being full of people who are genuinely interested in the breed. It's always nice to hear what the crowd are saying, things like great numbers in the ring", "great looking sheep".

With Blue Tongue restrictions in place, it was anticipated that there would be fewer sheep this year in all breeds. However, this was not the case and over all there were only about 500 less sheep than normal across the whole sheep section.

This year the Royal Welsh crown went to Huw Evans (Alltgoch) who once again, bred and produced some of the highest quality sheep we will see.

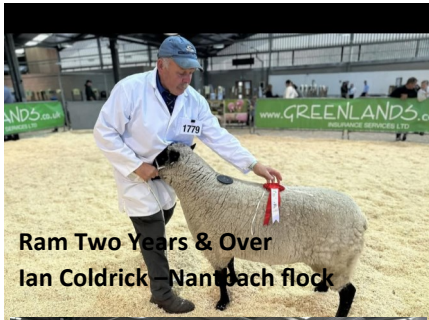
